## **Lubbock Title Industry Leader Posthumously Awarded Prestigious Honor at Statewide Conference**

AUSTIN – The Texas Land Title Association (TLTA), one of the state’s oldest trade associations, posthumously named Terry Grantham an honorary member for sustained meritorious service. The memorial honor was presented during the association’s Annual Conference and Business Meeting in Austin on June 20. The designation is in recognition of Grantham’s many contributions to the association and the title industry over a long period of time.

Grantham was a respected leader in the Texas business, serving as TLTA President in 2004-05 and as a member of the Board of Directors and on countless committees for the 20 years he was actively involved with the association. In 2003, he was recognized as TLTA Title Man of the Year and also served for six years as the first and only chair of TLTA’s Related Industries Committee. He was also dedicated to TLTA’s Political Action Committee, serving on the Board of Trustees and as a fundraising co-chair.

Grantham was the long-time owner of West Texas Title Company in Lubbock, and a partner in the law firm of Craig, Terrill, Hale & Grantham LLP. He was a proud member of the Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity while at Texas Tech, and remained active as an alumnus. He was also a coach and director for the Lubbock Youth Football League and the Western Little League for many years as his sons participated in baseball and football.
