I am in receipt of the Texas Land Title Association's (TLTA) Motion to Vacate and Motion for Rehearing and Reconsideration, which was submitted to the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) Office of the Chief Clerk on Wednesday, February 26, 2025, in response to Commissioner Order Nos. 2024-9045 and 2025-9125.

TLTA's motion requests that TDI:

1. Vacate Order No. 2025-9125;
2. Grant a rehearing of Docket No. 2851; and
3. Reconsider TLTA's rulemaking petition denial in 2024-9045, grant the petition, and publish its proposed rule.


Order No. 2025-9125 was issued under authority in Texas Insurance Code § 2703.202(c), not as the result of a contested case hearing. Insurance Code Chapter 2703 does not provide a process to request that an order be vacated or to request rehearing of a hearing conducted by the commissioner.

Order No. 2024-9045 was issued in response to a petition submitted under 28 TAC §1.202, and that section states that a petitioner has the right to request that the commissioner reconsider a decision.

I have reviewed the information included in TLTA's motion and reconsidered the information submitted in the petition submitted by TLTA. I have determined that Order No. 2024-9045 should stand.
