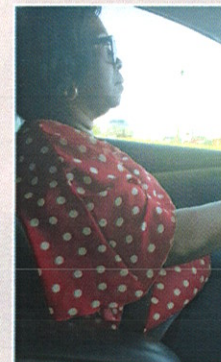
Shelia was always an entrepreneur and always had aspiration of owning her own businesses. She became the owner of The Total Look Boutique in Palestine, Texas.
